Happy New Year?

Happy New Year! It almost rolls off of our tongue on auto pilot, doesn't it? Sure... I expect it is most often a genuinely well-intended expression of good will toward whomever we say it. But does it carry any weight, in our minds or theirs? Do we actually hope for, or anticipate new happiness in 2023? Or is there some residual of the blindside, not so happy new year from 2020 still lurking around in our subconscious? Might there be some honest reasons for expecting some happy new year coming our way in January? I think that depends on our perspective.

For those who decline the Biblical perspective of life created and given by God who loves us and wants only good for us... you're pretty much free to make up, or believe anything you like. But no matter the alternative, it cannot carry the absolute guarantee of not only eternal life, but eternal happiness; a happiness that is, in fact emerging new continuously and never ending. Only the God who IS, and created all that is when there was not anything, can guarantee eternal anything, much less happiness.

In fact, anything or anyone other than that God, including our own imagination, cannot offer anything other than uncertainty and hopelessness beyond our own very temporary earthly existence. The word hope literally means confident expectation with pleasure. How far does your confident expectation with pleasure extend within the limitations of your personal power? Does everything in your life go the way you want it to? Does it ever not go the way you want? Why don't you change it before it goes bad? Because you can't.

Who holds absolute authority over what hasn't happened yet? Not you and me, that's for sure. Only the one and only uncreated, eternal past, present and future God is capable of that. Do any others claim such power and authority? Are you placing your eternal trust in that claim? I'm sorry to say I don't have any beachfront property in Wyoming to offer you. Nor would I, unless I were just as careless with my future.

And yet, I happily extend to you an honest invitation to a Happy New Year in 2023. Why? Because the God who IS guarantees, "if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come."

Can life still be hard and unhappy? It can and does. The perfection of completely new has not been fully delivered yet. Bad things happen to good people in this severely corrupted world.
