New in the New Year

What new things will the New Year hold? One dictionary definition of new is, "Different from the former or the old."

The Apostle Paul wrote the book of Philippians later in his life of ministry to Christ, and in His behalf. In **Philippi**ans 3:13 he wrote, Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

Though he had seen great effectiveness in many different places, he was not planning to repeat any of it. He had not established a system of ministry, universally applied all the time, everywhere. He was determined to discover however God wanted him to minister, fresh and new continually, just as Jesus said He did it.

John 5:19, Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner." *Again in John 6:38 He said,* "For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me." *Then in John 20:21 we read,* So Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you."

So we figure we should too. Though we don't know everything new the Lord will guide us into in 2025, there are two things we invite you to look forward to together.

You will be invited to some devoted times of prayer together before God. Jesus said, "When you pray", not if you pray. So, we will. In the same lesson He also encouraged us in **Matthew** 7:7-8 to, "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened." We believe Him, so we will pray in faith that He fully intends to keep His promise. We will also be calling you to embrace the sustained purpose of committing to invite people you know or meet to join with us in Sunday morning worship, and/or Life Group.
