Expectations

In our "Right Now!!" gotta have it world, how much does righteousness and faith actively, patiently, willingly wait for in hope... confident expectation with pleasure?

We just looked at some new and unexpected things God brought into some people's lives at the First Christmas: Mary & Joseph, Zacharias & Elizabeth, Simeon, Anna, a group of lowly shepherds and some wealthy, heathen foreigners. Oh, yeah... and Herod. Things God had already promised, but only one of them expected to receive.

What are some things He has promised He hasn't delivered yet? Do you think He may bring any of them forth in our lives in 2026? In yours?

Acts 1:9-11, Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel, who also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven."

I Corinthians 15:51-54, Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed—in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: "Death is swallowed up in victory."

I Thessalonians 4:14-17, For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus. For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Psalm 105:19, Until the time that his word came to pass, the word of the Lord tested him.

How are you handling the wait? How about Abraham. God promised him when he was 75 years old he would have a son by Sarah. He was 100 years old and it hadn't happened yet. Where do we park those promises while we wait... maybe a long time? Do we put them on a shelf? Do we take them out and dust them off regularly? Do we keep them alive?
