Don't you love those people who openly and obviously love you? They consistently go out of their way to demonstrate their love for you. It feels good and it's so easy to love them back. It's supposed to be that way.

That's the way God works. He loves us first, even when we ignore Him and don't give Him a thought, He loves us. Even when we openly live in ways that grieve Him and cause Him sorrow... He loves us. Yes, it can take consistent application for some people to believe it. But even if they don't, we get to love them anyway... just like He does.

Enjoy being completely safe and secure in His love for you. Then, enjoy being generous with love just like He is. People all around us are in desperate need of being loved. We get to bring it to them, and Christ is revealed.
