What Did He Say?

Have you ever been explaining something to someone that you believe is of great importance to both of you, and then they reveal that they didn't retain anything you said? Do you think that ever happened to Jesus?

He gave His first ever public teaching to His followers in **Matthew 5-7**, what we've come to call The Sermon on The Mount. He gave them, and us eight promises from God for blessing in the lives of those who live as He described, **5:3-12**. He followed it immediately with two declarations of what we are, salt & light, when we live that way, **5:13-16**. All of those attributes are present and evident in His life. He began giving us His life long before He went to the cross.

He then told them that He would personally fulfill everything required in all of the Law and the Prophets, 5:17-19. I think He really shook them when He told them the scribes and Pharisees' way of life was not qualified to enter the kingdom of heaven, 5:20.

Then He transitions into more than a dozen applications of what it means to live out what He has just given us. He begins many of those illustrations saying, "You have heard that it was said." He begins revealing how God defines it instead with, "But I say to you."

We all must decide whether we are going to believe what others say about The Lord and His ways, or what He says Himself. Toward the end of this all important first public teaching by Jesus, he warns about false teachers. He concludes by distinguishing between those who hear and do what He has told them, and those who heard but don't do it.

We live in a culture that does not listen and hear, a culture that resists being told what to do. Many exalt their own thinking above all others, even what The Lord Himself has told us. I exhort you to pay close attention to what The Lord has said to us, and give yourself to living accordingly. Romans 12:2 is certainly an encouragement for our times. "And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God."

It's interesting that He concludes His first ever public teaching by revealing that those who do what He has told us will be unshaken in the shaking. Those who hear and do not do what He says will see their lives collapse from the shaking.

THEY MEET THURSDAYS AT 6:45PM for a meal, worship, a message, and discussion groups!


