Are You Out Of Your Mind?

I hope so. Our own minds are too small. So, how do we access more than we're capable of alone?

Good news! Jesus said, "But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you." (John 14:26) So, let's expose our minds regularly to what He said and give the Holy Spirit something to work with.

Then He said, "No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you." (John 15:15) Followed by "However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you." (John 16:13-14)

Since He didn't say that just to them, Paul picked it up and passed it along to us all.

I Corinthians 1:10 & 2:16, Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment... For "who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct Him?" But we have the mind of Christ.

II Corinthians 13:11, Be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you. We need to share our minds with each other. Life Groups are a great place for that.

Philippians 1:27 & 2:2-5, Only let your conduct be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of your affairs, that you stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel.

Fulfill my joy by **being like-minded**, having the same love, being of one accord, **of one mind**. Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but **in lowliness of mind** let each esteem others better than himself. Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. **Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus**

And Peter exhorts us in I Peter 3:8, Finally, all of you be of one mind, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, be tenderhearted, be courteous

Romans 12:2 & 21, And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by **the renewing of your mind**, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God... Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

We are living in the midst of worldly, human thinking, values and conduct; exposed on many fronts. We can't avoid it. If we will live according to God's values, will and ways we will have to deliberately fill ourselves with His Word. Receiving from Him is the most valuable resource available to us.

It doesn't happen by accident.
