### Cultivated by God

Do you think of yourself as God does? If you do, it is very encouraging. Yet, too many of us settle for something far less; something too much influenced by what we, or someone else tends to think of us, or what we think they think of us. But we can know what God thinks of us because He makes it plainly known.

If you have received Christ Jesus, He says you are the good seeds He has lovingly planted in His field. You are the seeds He intends to cultivate that produce a seedbearing crop together. Yes, He said there are noxious weeds planted among us by His enemy. But He tells us He has plans for the weeds, and to not make them our concern.

He also tells us that though we seem to be tiny in the midst of everything, He will cause us to grow into something large enough to provide a safe environment for others to find a home, be at peace and multiply. He says that though on our own we seem insignificant and unspectacular, He will release His influence through us that will gradually change the environment around us. He will make us very influential without drawing attention to ourselves.

He goes on to say that if we will be on the lookout, He will reveal the treasures of heaven to us that most other people pass right by without recognizing. He will even entrust us to transact His heavenly business here on earth by discovering and trading in His own treasures of rare, valuable beauty; things that open the entrance to His heavenly realm. He said these treasures will so surpass the value of anything else we have, that we will eagerly swap our meager possessions for His.

He frees us to gather all sorts of people from around us. He tells us to trust Him to distinguish between everyone as we are faithful to Him in their midst, and with them among us. Our calling is to be influential as those who are His, not being influenced by any who are not.

He tells us to freely receive the newness He brings us, while not losing the value of what we have received from Him already. Both new and old are not supposed to be in competition with, or exclusive of each other.

He told us about all of this in **Matthew 13:24-52**, and He told us to pray for it all in **Matthew 6:9-10**. So pray in faith, anticipating He will answer with what He promised.
