Who is God?

There is much being posted these days about who God is. Some people are stating their belief there is no God. Some are affirming their beliefs about who God is. And some are denouncing who others believe God is.

For those who believe there is no God, why waste your time and effort discrediting folks who believe in what doesn't even exist? What an absolutely useless expenditure of your energy. What doesn't exist is unworthy of attempts to discredit. Do you work to expose the error of those who believe in the Tooth Fairy, or The Easter Bunny? Of course not. Doing so would make you appear to be the fool. Leave them alone to their delusions. They are not harming you, or attempting to impose anything on you, even if they are inviting you to join them in their beliefs. Politely decline and ignore them. They are no threat to you.

For those working to expose and denounce the beliefs of others you are convinced to be fallacies... are you attempting to convince people of what you think they should not believe? Defining your life by what you don't believe is a dead end street that leads nowhere positive. There is no hope there. Hope only exists for what we believe in and are encouraged in the expectation and anticipation of its future arrival.

There is another category of folks focused on God who do not accept the beliefs of others about who God is. They think instead, they should define who God ought to be. These are the most extraordinary God conscious people of all. To believe there is a God, and that we who are not God have the power and authority to define who God is requires notions of self that are truly amazing. And if I am not mistaken, the very concept of God presupposes a being more powerful than any human being.

Most who believe in a being who is God, believe that an actual God has the power to determine what happens to us, especially after our bodies expire. Any who think we simply turn into fertilizer have nothing to concern themselves with, do they?

Are there any who believe that who they have decided God ought to be will treat them according to their definition of that God? If there is such a God, wouldn't that God be capable of self-definition and expression? Wouldn't that God be able to protect that definition from corruption by mere humanity? If not, that's not much of a God.

But if that God did want to self-express in such a way as to be easily known and understood, how could that best be done? Do you think an all-powerful God would be capable of becoming present among humanity as human? If not, that's not much of a God. If that God were to do such a thing, do you think that living demonstration would be hidden and secret, or open and obvious for any and all to see and believe to be real?

There are many who are aware of the person of Jesus of Nazareth. How many know He declared Himself to be that very God? Speaking to those who were drawn to Him when He walked the earth He said, "He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?" (John 14:9) The apostle Paul wrote of Him, "For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily". (Colossians 2:9)

Do we believe Him? Or do we think He was a liar or a lunatic? Even famous atheists have acknowledged He is the most influential person who has ever lived and continues to be.

So what about you? Do you believe God is real? If you absolutely don't, I'm thankful you've read this far. If you think God may be real, and may have chosen to be most believable to people by becoming one of us, I encourage you to expose yourself to the historical accounts of the life of Jesus. The first four offerings in the New Testament of the Bible are the recountings of the life of Jesus written by four men; Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. Two of them were eye witnesses of what they wrote about Him. Two were written by men who came to know Him through the accounts of those who did live with Him then. I promise you this – it won't be boring.

After you've read of the accounts of His life, ask God to reveal to you what is true and what is not. Ask yourself if what you believe is worth entrusting your life to for all of eternity. Because your body will expire. It's the ultimate reality every honest person must acknowledge. What then? The risk of a guess? Or the hope of a promise? Choose well. There is no opportunity after our life has left our bodies behind.


