

Resurrected!!

Jesus Christ IS risen from the dead!!! Matthew, Mark & Luke all record it as it is. He IS risen!

It's not that He has risen, or was risen. **He IS risen!** This is no simple historical event, though it did happen. It is forever, from that point forward the eternal reality of who and what Jesus **IS**. Jesus the Son of Man, was fully human. And He fully died. But His forever, eternal living state is that of **Being Risen!!** This must be true if our faith is to be true.

I Corinthians 15:17, "And if Christ is not risen, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins!"

Our faith in His death, burial, resurrection and return are about far more than the forgiveness of our sin. After His resurrection He walked and talked among them for 40 days. They saw Him and heard Him. Thomas, who declared his unbelief unless he touched His very wounds, handled Him and His wounds. He was seen alive by more than 500 people. And... I Corinthians 15:42-43 & 51-54, "So also is the resurrection of the dead. The body is sown in corruption, it is raised in incorruption. It is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness, it is raised in power."

"Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed— in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must



put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: 'Death is swallowed up in victory.'"

Yes, today we celebrate the resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ. And in Him, we celebrate our own with Him. Hallelujah... What A Savior!!!
