He IS Risen!

Jesus IS risen from the dead! That is not only an historical fact, it is an eternal reality. It was unbelievable to some at the time. To some it still is.

Some of the women who had seen where He was buried came the next morning with spices prepared for his body. Finding the tomb empty, some angels asked them, "Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here. He is risen!" What must they have thought? They knew who He was. They had lived with Him. They had also seen Him die. All people die.
