### Triumphal Deliverance

Jesus and His followers were approaching Jerusalem for Passover. His miracles and fame had spread far and wide and word of His coming drew an excited crowd. People were hoping and looking for the promised Deliverer, the Christ. Isaiah had prophesied, "Of the increase of His government and peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, to order it and establish it with judgment and justice from that time forward, even forever."

We know about Simeon, that from the time of Christ's birth "It had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not die before he had seen the Lord's Messiah." And that Anna, "Coming in that instant she gave thanks to the Lord, and spoke of Him to all those who looked for redemption in Jerusalem."

Many people called Him Son of David, hoping He was in fact Messiah, the Christ. As they neared the city earlier, the mother of James and John asked, "Grant that these two sons of mine may sit, one on Your right hand and the other on the left, in Your kingdom."

Passover celebrated God delivering Israel from the godless government oppression of Egypt and Pharaoh. Many of the Jews in Palestine equated Caesar and Rome with Pharaoh and Egypt. They expected the Messiah to deliver them from godless governmental oppression again, once and for all. They lined the road, covering it with palm branches and their clothing as they shouted, "Hosanna to the Son of David! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!' Hosanna in the highest!" quoting Psalm 118:26. They believed their deliverance was at hand. Their hopes would be crushed in six days.

I wonder how many pondered it when He said during the following days, "For I tell you, you will not see Me again, until you say, 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord."

Three years earlier, "While He was in Jerusalem at the Passover Festival, many people saw the signs He was performing and believed in His name. But Jesus would not entrust Himself to them, for He knew all people."

I wonder how many of His followers today have slipped into a similar misplaced hope that He is bringing deliverance from unjust earthly government by way of public office holders.

Isaiah's prophecy will become reality... when "The Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God." Then Christ will rule and reign with those who are His for a thousand years, until the devil and evil will be banished forever.

For now it's Palm Sunday, but Friday is coming, and then... deliverance beyond what any human being can provide!
