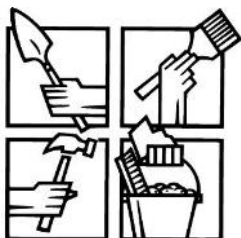

Christmas & Easter

I love these two celebrations of God brining His loving salvation to us. Christmas celebrates that the Lord chose to become God with us, one of us, womb to tomb and everything in between. Christmas celebrates that He came, which in itself is astounding! But Easter is why He came.

He came to live, die and rise from the dead for us ... for our benefit, at His expense. He came to take the just punishment for our sin, so He could justly exonerate us of the guilt and consequences we so richly deserved. He was brutally tortured and executed voluntarily, though He was completely innocent. Therefore He, and He alone is authorized to erase our sin and our guilt before God.

So... how should we then live?

Romans 6:3-11, Do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection, knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. For he who has died has been freed from sin. Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him, knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him. For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God. Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Galatians 2:20, I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.
