Spring

How much do the seasons have an impact on you; winter, spring, summer & fall? How much of an influence do you think God intended them to be? I am thankful to live somewhere on God's earth where all four of the seasons He ordained are clearly evident, none of them overly dramatic. They are so regular in their occurrence we may too easily take them for granted. Are they not evidence and expressions of who He is? Do we receive them from Him as such? Do we allow them to be of defining influence in our lives? Or are other things weightier?

*After the flood God said to Noah, "As long as the earth endures, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night will never cease." **Song of Solomon 2:11-13** encourages us in the springtime of life, "The winter is past; the rains are over and gone. Flowers appear on the earth; the season of singing has come, the cooing of doves is heard in our land. The fig tree forms its early fruit; the blossoming vines spread their fragrance." Pleasant and encouraging, don't you think?*

Do the evidences of sinful mankind everywhere tempt us to grant them greater influence in our lives than God's testimony in His creation? The evidence of God's faithfulness in creation is so reliable we can too easily allow it to be obscured by the threatening tumult of humanity screaming for our attention.

*Like Christ's disciples in **Luke 8:22-25**, Jesus has invited us to get into a boat with Him and travel across life's waters together to a place He calls the other side. The time, the place, the route, the boat, the destination and our participation are all of His choosing. We haven't included Him in our journey. He has invited us along in His.*

As you know, a violent, overpowering storm engulfed them as they went, obtained their full attention and deceived them into believing their lives were at risk. They allowed the earthly storm to so completely define them they lost sight of The Lord, still in the boat with them. When they did turn to Him, they had become so terror stricken they didn't recognize He was asleep, entirely unconcerned about what they had embraced as the commanding definition of their lives. Awakened, He rebuked the storm to peaceful stillness and asked them, "Where is your faith?" Where is ours? Where have we put it?

Are we proceeding forward on His journey with Him, confident He will successfully complete what He invited us to join Him in? Or, are we so captivated by the thundering, wave-tossed, earthly storms swirling around us we are desperately beseeching Him to rescue us from what isn't distressing Him at all? Or worse, attaching His name to endeavors He did not ever involve Himself in.

*Is it our purpose to be an expression of who He demonstrates Himself to be, just as He commissions us in **John 20:21**, when He said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you." Or are we frantically working to bail water, hoping to save the boat?*

Does spring occasionally bring a storm or two? Yes. Do the buds on the trees continue to swell with growth? Do the flowers still grow and birds build nests for chicks they will bring forth in new life? Which is greater? Should political, economic or social discord be allowed to rob us of the irrepressible, life-defining encouragement God's creation springs forth all around us?
