Where the strength is

I have owned six British sports cars over the years, most with wire wheels I cleaned with a tooth brush. I've given much consideration to wire wheels. The spokes start at the rim, spread out far apart from each other. They arrive very close together at the hub, and the strength of the wheel is at the hub.

Many Christians mistakenly think we travel along parallel lines toward the Lord. Parallel lines, however, never intersect. But the Bible says Jesus is the center of all things, and everything is traveling toward Him. If that's true, and we are traveling toward Him, we're traveling along convergent lines. The closer we get to Him the closer we get to each other, and that's where the strength is. The rim of the wheel is the boundaries of the community we serve in. By His design we are laced together to meet around Him for shared service in His behalf in our community. If the spokes loosen up, they lose the strength they provide for each other, and the wheel, as a whole is weakened.

This is true in our congregation, and among the congregations of our city. **I Corinthians** is written to the whole church in a city of 700,000 people; One Church, with many congregations. Paul makes it plain in **Ch. 1:10-13** & 12:12-27, that Christ's body is not to be divided. Chapter twelve reminds us that congregations need to need each other if the fullness of the body of Christ will be present and fully active where we live.

This summer we are entering into an experiment with our brothers & sisters of Calvary Fellowship Gig Harbor. We are working together to serve side by side as partners operating from the PCF facilities. June 18 & 25 we will enjoy joint worship services together at 10:00 AM. We'll have a BBQ out back after the June 25th service. For July & August we will conduct two Sunday morning services led by Calvary at 9:00 AM and PCF at 11:00 AM. Worship teams from each congregation will alternate every other week, ministering in both services.




