



God Given Rights!

July 4th is Independence Day in the United States. We celebrate declaring our separation from the governing authority of the King of England. We dedicate ourselves to the government of our own choosing, instead of one imposed upon us that denies many of the various God given rights we believe are due to all people. To that end we began our formal Declaration of Independence with the following statements.

"When in the Course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation. We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness."

For those dedicated to that declaration, myself included, regardless of how others may, or may have violated it; to possess those rights requires that we are also dedicated to not depriving any other person of those same rights. To do anything less would be transparent hypocrisy. It is appropriate that the first right declared is life itself. Without that, all of the others are, of course, meaningless. Dead people have no rights, on this earth.

This righteous declaration follows in the likeness of the separation God's Word calls us to make from the world around us that does not honor the Giver of Life, and life's rights. The apostle Paul reminds us in II Corinthians 6:17-18 that God call us to, "Therefore, 'Come out from among them and be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, and I will receive you. I will be a Father to you, and you shall be My sons and daughters, says the LORD Almighty.""

Sadly, the government of The United States, and many of the states within, now declare the violation of those God given rights to be righteous – to the point of even denying being made in God's own image & likeness, both male and female. What's worse, many of those states protect and provide the "right" to kill unwanted children.

When any government declares rights that deny and violate the far greater rights conferred by God, we must decide to separate ourselves from the false authority of those who consider themselves greater than God. Failure to do so makes us adversaries of God.

James 4:4-5 instructs us, "Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. Or do you think that the Scripture says in vain, 'The Spirit who dwells in us yearns jealously'"?

On this Independence Day, and every other day, let us declare ourselves to be separated from any & all earthly authority that would suppose to overrule the authority of God. And let us be separated **TO God** who loves us, and created us in His own image and likeness, then commissioned us to be living evidence of His great love and equality for all people.
