The Taste, Sight & Presence of Christ

Think of some foods you enjoy that are enhanced by certain spices. When my father was dealing with serious heart problems, he had to give up salt. But he found several Mrs. Dash seasonings that brought some of his favorite foods alive with flavor. Those same foods, without any seasonings were bland and uninviting.

Jesus said that His followers are the salt of the earth. (Matthew 5:13) He meant we are to be the godly flavor of the environment where we live. He then said that if that salt loses its flavor, it is good for nothing. Do we, you & I, receive and embrace that charge to live as the flavor of the Lord among those around us every day? If not, why not? If not, then what? And can we suppose to bring His fullness without each other? (Romans 12:4-5) He has not called any of us to the monastic life. We need to need each other (Ephesians 4:12-16), and the world around us needs us to be that way.

He then said that we are the light of the world that cannot be hidden. (*Matthew 5:14*) We have occasional power outages in Western Washington, usually during stormy fall & winter weather. What do we do when the power is out at night? We turn on battery powered lanterns in our house. Some folks use flashlights, some even light candles. What if we had guests in our home, or invited neighbors in to provide comfort for them during the time of need. Would we let them stumble around in the dark? We would not. The darkness of the world without Christ presents a far greater need. Is it our purpose to provide light for them, that they might not needlessly stumble in the darkness for lack of light? If not, why not? If not, then what?

If we don't, are we keeping His light, entrusted to us, under a basket? (*Matthew 5:15*) He then exhorts us to let our light shine so clearly that it can be seen by how we live, and that being so seen also glorifies God our Father in their sight.

He goes on to tell us to ask God for His will to be present and evident here on earth, just as it is in heaven. (*Matthew 6:10*) Later He tells us that the kingdom of heaven (here and now) is like His presence in us, deposited and influential among the environment we live in. (*Matthew 13:33*) Do we, you & I, actively live to demonstrate the influential presence of Christ in us and among us? If not, why not? If not, then what?

We do have an example of people who lived like that together, and how God responded to it. (Acts 2:42-47) Can we be that same type of active presence together, here and now? If not, why not? If not, then what? But if so, then quite possibly Acts 2:47. We can only do our part, and trust God to do His.
