Where The Fish Are

Jesus did some extraordinary things to make redemption available to us. Other than conceiving and planning the whole thing, how did He start? We could ask, where did He start from? He started enacting His plan in heaven. He lived there in absolute perfection with The Father and The Holy Spirit.

He could have gone about it, while there, in any way $\tilde{H}e$ chose, and He chose to do it on earth and personal; eye to eye, skin to skin, one human being with other human beings, and through them to all of the humans who would occupy earth after them. Now here we are, the whole process handed off to us — **John 17:20** & **20:21**. So, how shall we go about it? The Samaritan woman at the well is a perfect example, **John 4:4-41**. He discarded several established religious and cultural boundaries by reaching out to her. Peter was later called to leave the established boundaries behind when God sent him, against his initial objections, to the home of a gentile – even a Roman army officer, **Acts 10:9-48**.

What are the religious and cultural boundaries Jesus wants to cross today to make redemption available to people floundering without it? Of course, He wants us to cross those boundaries for Him, as His body alive in the world today. Are they sexual, political, racial, gender, economic or philosophical? How about generational?
