It's In The Details

I've been thinking about microscopes and telescopes. From looking into the tiniest sub-microscopic particles, or out into deep space through Hubble and Webb telescopes, the details are astounding!

I watched a program about a brain surgeon who is doing non-invasive, ultra-sound brain surgery. He can accurately target and remove the plaque on blood vessels in the brain that cause Alzheimer's. He uses the same technology to bring relief from Parkinson's disease and addiction compulsions. Lest you think this is snake oil or smoke & mirrors, patients and family members demonstrate and testify to the restored lives they have gained through this surgery.
