Are We Thankful Now?

The shortest command in the New Testament is found in Colossians 3:15, "And be thankful." So, are we?

I'm thinking of the father of our faith, Abraham. He believed God for a long time for a promise God had not delivered on. We're talking decades here. Do you think he was thankful all those years when God's promise had not yet come true?

Then Finally! God comes through, after bluntly confronting Sarah about her mocking God's as yet undelivered promise. Isaac is born, and Abraham has a son at last, through whom God's great promises can come. Do you think Abe was thankful now? in spite of their unfortunate attempts to deliver one on their own by way of a surrogate.

Isaac has grown up to be a strapping young man when God says to Abraham, "Take your son, your only son, whom you love—Isaac—and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on a mountain I will show you." Do you think he was thankful then?

"Early the next morning Abraham got up and loaded his donkey. He took with him two of his servants and his son Isaac. When he had cut enough wood for the burnt offering, he set out for the place God had told him about." I wonder if he was thankful, don't you?

After three days journey he sees the place God mentioned. So, he tells his servants to wait while the two of them go off to worship, and then they'll be back. He loads the wood on his son, grabs the fire and his knife and they start walking. What about now? Is he thankful now?

Walking along his son says, Hey Dad, we've got wood and fire, but no lamb for the burnt offering. Abe says, not to worry son. God will provide for Himself a lamb for the burnt offering. Is he stalling? What is he thinking? Is thankfulness his state of being?

I can only imaging what Abraham is thinking as he builds the altar, stacks the wood and ties up his son before putting him on the altar. I have no idea what Isaac is thinking as his father lifts the knife in the air to slay him with. Is the father of our faith expressing some form of thanks as he prepares this final act that must surely seem like the death of his God given dreams?

But just as he begins, God calls his name – Abraham! He pauses and replies, I'm here. And God says, "Do not lay a hand on the boy or do anything to him. For now I know that you fear God, since you have not withheld your only son from Me." I think he may have been overcome with thankfulness at that point.

Of course, God then revealed a ram in the bushes that served as the burnt offering instead of his son, and Abraham named the place "The-Lord-Will-Provide." Then God said, "Because you have done this thing and have not withheld your only son, I will indeed bless you... And all the nations of the earth will be blessed by your offspring because you have obeyed My command."

Than once again he was given a promise beyond his comprehension, and with him we have become the beneficiaries of the blessings to be thankful for. My challenge, and maybe yours too, is to not let life's adversities rob me of being thankful to the Giver of Life who has promised us everything in His Son.


