Thankful for Priorities

God, who IS relationship – Father, Son & Holy Spirit, made us like Himself for relationship. Because that is the very essence of the reason and purpose for our being, every aspect of our life should find its rightful place within a relational foundation. As we enter this Thanksgiving month, please join in reaffirming God's relational priorities for our lives.

God formed the first human being, Adam, of the physical stuff He had made already. Then He breathed the breath of life into him and he became a living being. From that point on Adam lived in relationship with God. God spoke to him and gave him authority and responsibilities. Adam did well, but he saw the earthly relationships given to animals and longed to have a complimentary human relationship for himself.

God acknowledged it was not good for Adam to be the only one of his kind. So, He took some of the physical being Adam was already, and built a "complimentary opposite counterpart" for him. (English is a little lacking with that word) Then, Adam was in a living relationship of his own kind, and they were now in a relationship with God and each other. At this point, God had completed creation and sent these two people on the life purposes they were made for. These two relationships, with God and in marriage, became the foundation all other resulting relationships are meant to rest upon.

Yes – when we are living in right relationship with God, every other involvement of our life should have right relationship at its foundation. The full menu of relationship priorities is first God, then marriage, followed by family, church, and the world, in that order; each one added to and built upon the priorities before it. If our relationship with God is not our top priority, our marriage will not enjoy the secure foundation it is designed for. If marriage becomes first instead of God, it will be weakened and vulnerable. If our marriage relationship is not actively dependent on and actively connected with God, both are at risk. Adam and Eve demonstrated that, and we are now even more vulnerable than they were.

Since we are thankful for our God given relationships, and want them to enjoy every benefit He provides, we are offering some opportunities to affirm our relationships with God and in our marriages.

Sunday morning, November 5th, any & all married couples are invited to renew our marriage vows together in a special service that will begin at 11:30, rather than 11:00 AM. Since we'll have an extra hour that day anyway, returning to Pacific Standard Time, it will be easy to make it on time.
