Thankfulness

I am thankful we have a national holiday for Thanksgiving as a dedication to thank God for every good thing in our lives. As His Word reminds us in **James 1:17**, "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning." In our world so troubled with grief and sorrow, being thankful to God for what is good protects us from discouragement and despair.

God's Word has much to say about being thankful, and warnings about the consequences of being unthankful. I'm going to suggest three short portions of His Word that help us stay focused with thankfulness.

I Thessalonians 5:18 says, "Give thanks in everything, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." Life has some difficult circumstances. But don't let them define life for you, or rob you of the reassurance thankfulness brings for the good things you have in Christ.

Ephesians 5:20 calls us to be, "Giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ." This can be more challenging. We can wind up with things in our life we are not inclined to be thankful for. Given the choice, we would decline. But we can be thankful that God wants to use these very things to impart assets to us that build us up because we have endured them.

And lastly, **Colossians 3:15** says, "And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and **be thankful**." God calls us to be many things as followers of Christ, and the exhortation to be thankful is one of them.

When we are confronted with things tempting us to not be thankful... without denying them, turn to God first, and thank Him before expressing any contrary impulse or emotion. Start small with the clothes you are wearing, your last meal, or your next one. Thank Him for the home you live in, or the bed you sleep in. Thank Him for the people you love, and the ones who love you. Thank Him for Christ, who suffered and died in our behalf and has given us eternal life in the perfection He is preparing for us even now. Thank Him for the ones you know who are already there waiting for you.

Psalm 139:13-16, "For You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mother's womb.

I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Marvelous are Your works,
And that my soul knows very well.
