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A Pleasant Commandment

Colossians 3:15, “And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful.”

Sometimes the word commandment conjures up the impression of an action directive; Go here, do this, etc. But a commandment from God is simply Him revealing His will for us. He is graciously directing us into the best possible course for a life that will afford us the greatest measure of His blessing.

Colossians 3:15 presents a delightful commandment. It begins with an appeal to enjoy the highest level of personal security we can know in life; “let the peace of God rule in your hearts.” The fruit of the Spirit that is self-control (**Galatians 5:23**) encourages us to voluntarily submit our will to God, like Jesus did. (**John 6:38 & 20:21**) Having done that, He now invites us to allow His own absolute relational security, “the peace of God,” to “rule in your hearts.” Who would not want the peace of God to rule in our hearts?

*Of course, that relational security requires relationship, and the word here points out that God’s calling in our lives is to enjoy His own relational security with each other in the body of Christ we occupy together. Are we willing to live in that peace with each other in His behalf; actually, actively with the Father, Christ Jesus, and each other? (**John 17:20-21**) If we are, we are empowered to receive and obey His command to “be thankful.”*

*We are obviously living in a world that is, in large part not thankful, but rather given over to un-thankfulness, complaint and criticism. God’s word warns us about the perils of not being thankful. **Romans 1:20-21**, “For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse, because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, **nor were thankful**, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.”*

What should we be thankful for? I typically limit these monthly articles to 500-700 words. To even attempt to list all we have to be thankful for would require a book. Even that would need to be limited to the basics. But at the very least, with this commandment we should be thankful to God for providing His own peace for us to receive and govern our lives together in the body of Christ we are living participants in.

*Thanksgiving Day every November is a nice reminder to emphasize the many benefits we have to be thankful for. It’s interesting that our national recognition of a Day of Thanksgiving originated in 1863, in the midst of the Civil War. As God’s people, being thankful is an established attribute of our lives of faith. The Lord’s Prayer, **Matthew 6:9-13**, is revealed to be a daily prayer. I think **Colossians 3:15** could be considered an appropriate addendum to our daily prayers to the Father, with Christ Jesus. He did invite us to pray “Our Father” with Him.*

*I include you near the top of my list of what I am thankful for in my life. You are my family, **Matthew 12:49-50**, and we are God’s primary delivery system of His blessings to each other.*

theme is: Thanksgiving! PCF will provide the plates, utensils, water and ham. Bring a side or dessert to share! Looking forward to fellowshiping together!



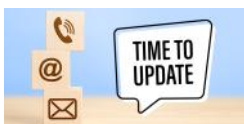
PCF Soulfire Youth
