## Waiting for Jesus

The Temple was quiet as the old man walked in. He deliberately came at times when few others did. He appreciated the passionate prayers of others. He was very passionate in prayer himself. But some of them were so loud, and went on so long he found it a distraction. He had become confident for many years that God received him and heard his prayers; sometimes He even met him personally. He would never tell anyone about it. They may think him presumptuous at best. But sometimes it was so overwhelming he couldn't hold back. The emotional impact left him sobbing. He didn't want to be a distraction to others, either. Once someone had asked him, sincerely, "Is something wrong? Have you lost someone?" He didn't even look up. Not only was nothing wrong, it was so devastatingly good he didn't know if he could survive it.

He had been on his knees, face to the ground for some time and was unaware of anyone else having entered. Softly he spoke, "Lord... how long? It has been so many years. I have believed the prophesies since I was young. I do not doubt. And I know I heard You those many years ago. I do not doubt. I feel like what the Psalmist wrote in **Psalm 105:19** of Joseph, that until the time that his word came to pass, Your Word to him tested him. Help me Lord. Sometimes I grapple with discouragement. How will I know?"

He had not even heard Anna enter, and would not have known her. They had never met. She had seen him many times though. She was frequently there in prayer and had made note of both his passion and he preference for solitude. She, too had been waiting for the coming of Messiah, though she had no personal sense of when, and certainly no expectation He would come in her lifetime. Yet, the solitude allowed her to hear his spoken words of prayer, and prompted her to wonder.

Simeon continued, "Lord... I am old. I know You know that. And I am not complaining, at least that is not my intention. But if I have understood You, I have hoped that I will live to see Him when He comes. Lord... does anyone else have that same expectation?"

Little could he know that what he had waited years for, what represented his primary hope for living on the earth before leaving it behind for the promise of heaven, was less than a month away. King David's prayer in **Psalm 27:4** expressed his reason for living. **Verses 13** and **14** were his very heart to carry on.
