Christmas Hope

What have you ever hoped to receive for Christmas? Of course, when Jesus was born to Joseph and Mary, they were the only ones expecting Him that day, and Christmas was not yet initiated. But... some people were waiting expectantly.

Luke 2:25-26, "And behold, there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon, and this man was just and devout, waiting for the Consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him. And it had been revealed to him by the Holy Spirit that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ."

All of Israel knew that the coming of Messiah was promised. But it had been a long time. I think it is safe to suppose that most who believed the Promised One would come had no expectation He would arrive any time soon. It appears that even Mary's parents doubted the fantastic story she had told them.

I don't doubt that many of you have received some promises delivered by God. But the reality remains that the vast majority of what He has promised is still out in front of us. We do not know when the fullness of time for their delivery will come. Of Christ's return, even He said, "But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father." (Mark 13:32)

Even though, unlike Christmas, we do not know when God will deliver the many promises He has already prepared, I pray we anticipate His delivery of them, waiting in the patience, comfort, hope and confidence of faith. Please freely thank Him for them before they arrive... keeping oil in your lamp.

It's hard to hope for what we don't know. So, unlike some who allow themselves to be discouraged by what has not become reality in our lives yet, please continue to read and recount God's promises in His Word, and fix your hopes on Him who promised them, rather than the timing of their delivery. Remember, Biblical hope means "Confident Expectation with Pleasure." Hope only exists for what we don't have yet.

Embrace the Hope of Christmas. **Colossians 1:27**, "To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory."


