Humble Obedience Matthew 3:1-17

Obedience doing what has been asked of

Col. 2:12 – Buried with Him in Baptism

Obedience is one of the biggest desires we
have for our kids

Baptism isn't where you find Jesus, it is
what you do when you find Him

Obedience to the Father is what He 1st
desired

Acts 8 – Philip and the eunuch

Gen 2:16-17 - Obedient in the Garden
before sin

2.) Jesus the humble example

Jesus was not a sinner, He had no reason
for having to be baptized...

Gen 17:1-2 - Abraham "Obey faithfully..."

Yet He did it humbly because it is what the
Father wanted Him to do

Our Father has called us to live in obedience

Even John thought that Jesus didn't need to
be baptized. But this was from a sinners and
human view ...

1.) Baptism done in humble obedience

Matt. 3:2 & 11 - Repent

Acts 2:38-41 - Repent and turn

But Jesus was determined to set an
example.

Matt. 3:13-15

The religious leaders did not get this!

Acknowledging the change that must
happen in your life

Jesus humbles Himself to do what God has
asked.

Repenting before others

This was done as obedience to the Father.

Commitment to a new identification

Jesus LIVED a life of FOLLOWING and
OBEYING what the Father says and does.

This New Identity

We are baptized to identify with Him

Gal. 3:27 – Clothed in Christ

John 5:19 & John 14:31

3.) The Fathers' Joy

Obedience brings the Father GREAT JOY

Matt. 3:17

Fathers' joy in His obedient Son

Matt. 25:23 – Well done good and faithful...

The Fathers joy when we humbly and
faithfully OBEY
