## Godly Conduct Hebrews 13:1-8

- I. Love one another
  - A. Be at peace with all men (Romans 12:9-21)
    - 1. Be genuine (not a hypocrite)
    - 2. Be humble (Psalm 147:6)
    - 3. Be hospitable (Mark 9:39-41)
    - 4. He was/is the same for us (Philippians 2:5-11)
  - B. Treat everyone as if God has sent them to you
    - 1. An angel by definition is a sent one
    - 2. We are given opportunities to show others who God is (Matthew 5:14-16)
- II. Be content
  - A. Fearing the loss of stuff can make you miss out (Matthew 19:21-24)
    - 1. We should be content through our relationship to Christ
    - 2. We should be willing to do what He asks because He is our contentment
  - B. God will never leave us or forsake us
    - 1. He has left us the Holy Spirit (John 14:25-27)
    - 2. We can speak with Him (John 15:15-17)
  - C. God is our helper so we need not fear anything
    - 1. God has unlimited resources
    - 2. Man can only destroy the body (Matthew 10:28)
      - a. We are here to do God's will
      - b. When we die we will be with God
- III. See the results of Godly conduct
  - A. We can see the results of godly conduct in others
    - 1. Paul and others are godly examples (Philippians 3:12-17)
    - 2. We can see it in her Christian friends
      - a. We almost instinctively know what Godly conduct looks like
      - b. We have the Bible to let us know for sure
  - B. We can have godly conduct in ourselves
    - 1. Be of the same mind as Christ (Philippians 2:5-11)
      - a. Jesus sacrificed Himself for others
      - b. Jesus was obedient
    - 2. Thinks on good things (Philippians 4:8-9)
  - C. We can be an example of godly conduct to others
