John 1:1-4, "In the beginning (when the beginning began) was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and

without Him nothing was made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men."

Genesis 1:26-27 & 2:7, "Then God said, 'Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the livestock, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.' So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them."

"And the LORD God formed the man of the dust of the ground, and **breathed into his nostrils the breath of life**; and the man became a living being."
