Smaller than seeds

Matthew 6:9-10, "In this manner, therefore, pray:
Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your
kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it
is in heaven."

Jesus told us to pray, "Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven."

.....

- Then He said, "The kingdom of heaven is like..."

Matthew 13:33-35, He told them another parable. "The kingdom of heaven is like leaven that a woman took and hid in three measures (50-60 pounds) of flour, till it was all leavened." Jesus spoke all these things to the crowd in parables; he did not say anything to them without using a parable. So was fulfilled what was spoken through the prophet: "I will open my mouth in parables, I will utter things hidden since the creation of the world." Why?

Remember the parables of the **four soils** and the **tares** & **wheat**? He told us before;

"Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened." (Matthew 7:7-8)

They asked Him for understanding of the parables, and He gave it to them

- Shall we?

What should we ask for in light of the last three parables?

- **The field** of tares & wheat
- The growth of the mustard tree
- **The yeast** and the flour

13:33 vs the **unleavened bread** of Passover

- Leaven = influence from within, good or had
- Egyptian, U.S. or religious cultural influence among us

Matthew 16:6 & 12, Jesus said to them, "Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and the Sadducees... Then they understood that He did not tell them to beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine (teaching) of the Pharisees and Sadducees.

Two things are consistent about God's **heavenly kingdom on earth** so far:

- Some important things are **tiny** & **hidden**
- Seeds grow to maturity when planted in the soil
- Yeast is a change agent when hidden in the flour

"The kingdom of heaven is like leaven that a woman took and hid in three measures (50-60 pounds) of flour, till it was all leavened."

Vs. 33, Hid = concealed within

Vs. 35, Hidden = kept secret

Yeast, like the seed, is deliberately inserted **as an** inconspicuous kingdom deposit

- It doesn't come in with a marching band
- It isn't even noticed until it is growing

A speck of yeast is even smaller than a mustard seed

Yeast is a living organism

.....

- Its power is released when deposited in inert (lifeless) flour
- Acts 1:8, But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come on you, and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."
- (the field & flour)

Flour is not going to **become** anything unless **it is changed**

- It will remain **lifeless** & without influence
- Yeast will not become like its surroundings

Yeast is already living (unlike salt, Matt.5:13)

- It is unyielding, uncompromising
- It will change its surroundings

Seeds multiply within the environment they occupy

- When planted, **seeds** duplicate & produces **more seeds**...
- **That then produce** more seeds, etc., etc., etc..
- Left in the bag, they do nothing

Yeast **changes the environment** it occupies

.....

- Yeast transforms the formerly lifeless environment it grows in
- The flour can never return to its former state
- Unlike flour, people are not passive

Acts 17:2-6, As usual, Paul went to the synagogue, and on three Sabbath days reasoned with them from the Scriptures, explaining and showing that

the Messiah had to suffer and rise from the dead:
"This Jesus I am proclaiming to you is the
Messiah." Then some of them were persuaded and joined Paul and Silas, including a great number of God-fearing Greeks, as well as a number of the leading women. But the Jews became jealous, and they brought together some scoundrels from the marketplace, formed a mob, and started a riot in the city. Attacking Jason's house, they searched for them to bring them out to the public assembly. When they did not find them, they dragged Jason and some of the brothers before the

The history of the New Testament, **from** Christ's ascension in **Acts 1:8**...

city officials, shouting, "These men who have

turned the world upside down have come here

- To John's writing of Revelation probably spanned about 60-70 years.
- During which the known world was impacted by the seeds & yeast of the kingdom
- Are we living like they did in the field & flour that is our world?
- If not, how would God have us to change our M/O?
- Do we still pray, "Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven."
