Matthew 5:3-12, God's promise to bless

- A solid life in a shaky world
- Matthew 7:24-27

Vs. 13-16, Our clear calling & purpose

- Soaking in **Christ's flavor**, keeping it **fresh**
- Being **the wick** in the lamp of **His light**
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Vs. 17-20, Jesus - the Fullness of God's Word

- Keeping His life (Vs. 3-16) fulfills the law
- Be careful who you follow
- It's not about performance
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- Vs. 21-26, Life from the heart (Christ's)

Vs. 21, "You have heard that it was said..."

- **By who**... God, or others speaking about Him?

Vs. 22, "But I say to you..."

- We have God's word from Him who IS The Word
- Trust, but verify **Acts 17:10-11**

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"Whoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment."

Proverbs 7:11, "God is angry with the wicked every day."

Vs. 22, "Angry" = Passionate Wrath

James 1:20, "The wrath of man does not produce the righteousness of God."

Righteous wrath belongs to God, (Rom. 1:18-32)

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"Raca" = **Worthless** (made in God's image & likeness)

- Who God values enough to die for

"Fool" = Godless heart (Psalm 14:1 & 53:1)

- Speaking condemnation
- "The Three Stooges"

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Titus 3:2, "Speak evil of no one, be peaceable, gentle, showing all humility to all men."

- Our world is **overflowing** with evil speaking & condemnation
- If we're not deliberate about our salt & light, we'll be corrupted
- Driving up Soundview Tuesday morning

James 3:3-10

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Vs. 23-24, "Has something (*legitimate*) against you" (*Vs.* 11)

Respond to unjust accusations like Jesus –
Don't

"Leave your gift there **before the altar**"

That is where conviction lives

God doesn't receive impure offerings (Vs. 8)

- Nothing is more valuable to Him
- John 13:34 & 17:20-23

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"First be reconciled to your brother (Vs. 9)

- What do we value more highly than restored relationship? (Peace)

John 14:27, "Peace I leave with you. My peace I give to you."

"And **then** come and offer your gift."

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*Vs. 25a, "*Reach a settlement quickly with your adversary"

- Why? What if you are being wronged?

This disagreement is before man, not God

How did Jesus settle our wrong against Him?

- Romans 5:8 & Hebrews 12:2
- The oil to light this lamp is very valuable

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Vs. 25*b*- 26, "Lest your adversary deliver you to the judge... and you be thrown into prison. Assuredly, I say to you, you will by no means get out of there till you have paid the last penny."

- What judge? God
- What prison? Unforgiveness

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Murder & crimes against humanity?
