## You Asked For It, Pt. 5

## Finding Hidden Treasure

Matthew 6:9-10, "In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven."

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Who is invited to pray this prayer together?

- Everyone who believes Jesus
- We can't pray "**Our Father**" for ourselves alone.

Jesus begins telling us **God's answer to our prayer Vs. 24**, "The kingdom of heaven is like **a man** who **sowed good seed in his field**"

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Vs. 31, "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed, which a man took and sowed in his field"

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**Vs. 33**, "The kingdom of heaven is like **leaven**, which a woman took and **hid** in three measures of meal"

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Matthew 13:44, "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and hid; and for joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field."

Vs. 33, "hid" = Intentionally concealed, deposited within

Vs. 35 & 44, "hidden & hid", "hid" & "kept secret" = Intentionally kept secret/unrevealed...

To be found by those seeking

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- Vs. 24, 31, 38 & 44, "field" = Farm land
  - Vs. 38, Jesus explained that, "the field is the world"
  - So, God is seeding, depositing & farming in the world
  - "On earth as it is in heaven"

**Vs. 44**, "the kingdom of heaven is like **treasure** 

hidden in a field"

- "treasure" = a deposit of wealth beneath the surface in the world
- What is the treasure? The kingdom of heaven on earth

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Vs. 44, "which a man found"

- What sort of man found it?

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- How did he find it?

Proverbs 2:1-5, My son, if you receive my words, and treasure my commands within you, so that you incline your ear to wisdom, and apply your heart to understanding; Yes, if you cry out for discernment, and lift up your voice for understanding, If you seek her as silver, and search for her as for hidden treasures; Then you will understand the fear of the Lord, and find the knowledge of God.

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*Matthew 5:6, "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled."* 

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Matthew 7:7-11, "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. Or what man is there among you who, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent? If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!"

Asks for, seeks and knock for... **What?** (some people torture that promise beyond belief)

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Matthew 6:9-10, "In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven."

- That's the foundation of the ask

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*Matthew 13:24, 31, 33 & 44, "The kingdom of heaven is like..."* 

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If we believe Him, so far we are asking for ...

- A bumper crop of godly seed, to BE & plant
- In Christ's behalf, in His field that is The World
- Knowing there will be weeds among them
- Trusting God to do the weeding at the end

We are also asking for...

- Inconspicuous seeds of **who Jesus is**...

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 That will grow to become a welcoming environment And that our kingdom deposit is also ...

- A living *influential agent* of God's kingdom presence...
- That gradually changes the environment we live in
- One person at a time, like Philip & Nathanael

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These are all present simultaneously...

- Orchestrated by the King
- Hold them all in your hand for God to use as He wants

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How else do we pray for God's kingdom to be evident on earth?

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Matthew 13:44, "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and hid; and for joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field."

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"treasure **hidden in a field**, which a man **found** and **hid**"

- The kingdom is the treasure.
- He didn't **remove it** from where he found it
- He preserved the place where God put it
- He may have added mustard seed & leaven to increase its presence

He exchanged **all other value he had** for God's

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treasure

- So did the apostle Paul

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**Philippians 3:7-8**, But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ. Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ

 Is there anything we value more than our King?

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Given the kingdom realities we've learned so far ...

- Are we, you & I, deposited in the world for people to find?
- Do we see ourselves as being here **to be** *found*?
- Are we evidence of **having something more valuable** than everything else we own?
- Is it of great value to us **because** we asked, sought & knocked to obtain it?

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Is the offering of our deposit, like David's in **II** Samuel 24:24?

- "I will not offer to the Lord my God burnt offerings that cost me nothing."
- Can other's see how valuable it is to us?
- Do we live in such a way that others would want what we have?

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He was looking (7:7-8) for **more than what is** laying on the surface.

- The treasure of God's kingdom is "hidden", deposited in "the field"

- Are we **taking it** out of the church, **into God's field**?

- Might we be suspected of being with Jesus...

- For Christ's benefit, and those who need to find Him with us
