Kingdom Merchants

Matthew 7:7-8, "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.
What do we value enough to ask God for?
Matthew 6:9-10, "In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it
is in heaven."
 In Matthew 13:24-52 He reveals the kingdom to us
1) Seeds God sows (including us) in the weed
strewn world2) Seeds planted will grow & become a benefit
to others
3) Our deposit will be a change agent in our
environment
4) On the lookout for God's valuables
concealed in the world around us
*More valuable than anything else we have
Matthew 13:45-46, "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking beautiful pearls, who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had and bought it."

Vs. 44 Also began, "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like"

- Each example is like a link in a chain
- Not a separate, isolated application
- We asked, what type of person found this treasure?

.....

Vs. 45 is a different type of seeker

Looking for **specific** treasure

Like the body parts illustrated in I Corinthians 12:12-27...

These **different parts** of the kingdom are interdependent.

This kingdom seeker is "a merchant seeking beautiful pearls"

- Are you here to **transact commerce** in kingdom valuables?
- Are you looking for things **especially** valuable to God?
- Deposits that are expressions of who God is
- Are you hoping to do the business of **heaven** on earth?

Pearls represent beauty, wisdom & great value

.....

- - **Revelation 21:21**, The gates of the New Jerusalem are made of pearls
 - **Proverbs 31:23**, The gates of a city are where wisdom & authority are transacted (Wise wives empower their husbands)
 - Matthew 7:6, Jesus warned to not cast our pearls before swine

The kingdom seeker in **Vs. 44** was **looking in** God's field, the world Where are you looking for pearls of the kingdom? The **Word of God** is a minefield worth searching - **Proverbs 2:1-5, 4:5-9, 8:1-9:**6 & **13:20** are good places to start How much are you willing to invest? - **How much** did this merchant pay? - What is **most valuable** to you? - How about your **time** & **effort**? If you come to the Word of God, looking for God... He'll see that you don't leave empty handed... With treasures that do not decrease in value **Matthew 6:19-21**, "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not

and where thieves break in and steal; but lay up for break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

Who did he buy the pearl for?

- We can't give what we don't have, so yes... to possess
- The mustard seed was sown to grow & provide opportunity for others
- The leaven was deposited to change its environment

James 4:3, "You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend it on your pleasures."

What is more valuable than anything else we could have?

- Jesus, but not only for our salvation
- Deposits of **who He is** we can embrace as our own...
- To make available to others, also

John 20:21, "As the Father has sent Me, I also send you."
