- <b>His net</b> , not ours	<ul> <li>Embraced as members of the family</li> </ul>

Some nets are designed to catch certain fish (size of spacing)	- Not unlike the wheat and the tares
- This net was for catching everything, even	

dragging bottom

(Larger & heavier, sinks to the bottom)

What about those who don't receive Christ?
