- I. Our Mission
 - A. What's the mission?
 - 1. Go out and makes disciples.
 - 2. Love God love others.
 - 3. Obey.
 - B. How do we do that?
 - 1. Honestly (James 2:14-17)
 - 2. Consistently (1 Cor 9:24-27)
 - 3. Specifically (1 Cor 9:19-23)
 - 4. Personal
 - a. It isn't about ruling the world or a large following (John 6:15)
 - b. It isn't about forced obedience (Matt 12:3-8)
- II. First Hand Evangelism (Jer 31:31-34)
 - A. Making disciples is more involved than just teaching. (Matt 28:18-20)
 - 1. It's about encouraging learning and following
 - 2. It is applicable for all walks of life (nations)
 - a. some nations were against them
 - b. they were against some nations
 - c. some nations were just coexisting
 - 3. It's asking to identify publically with the ideology (baptism)
 - 4. It's teaching (not just telling) them how to live (obey)
 - B. God is wanting to raise people up and He is drawing them. (John 6:43-47)
 - 1. He wants to be known
 - 2. He wants to raise people to life with Him
 - C. Jesus demonstrated what evangelism/discipleship look like (John 13:34-35)
 - 1. He tells us how to know if we are disciples.
 - a. Do you love those God is drawing to Himself? (Mark 2:13-17)
 - b. Are you wanting to be a light in the darkness? (Matt 4:15-17, 5:14-16)
 - 2. Do you see God's words as life? (John 6:68)
- III. What can you do?
 - A. Are you excited for what God is doing in your life?
 - 1. Intentionally think about what God is doing in you.
 - 2. Ask God to show you
 - B. Do your actions reflect Who Jesus is in your life?

- 1. Read the gospels and read all of His Word
- 2. Pray for guidance
- 3. Ask for guidance
- C. Are you willing to share Who God is?
 - 1. Make the decision beforehand
 - 2. Be prepared in your own mind
 - 3. Keep an eye out for opportunities
- D. Be who God has made you to be
 - 1. God isn't asking you to be fake
 - 2. God is guiding you, so trust His leading
 - 3. Have integrity, but stretch yourself. Grow.
