Praying God's Will Matthew 6:11-15

Let's make it real & say it together ...

- "Our Father in heaven"

That sounds even **better in heaven** than it does here

- And it's the power of heaven here

What did you come **to give** today?

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- Have you come to give God Worship &
 Praise...
- Thanks, Service & Prayer?
- Have you come to give Him your absolute reliance & dependance upon Him...
- Your commitment to do His will?
- We just declared that in Vs. 10

As we continue, He wants us to **give what He gives**

Vs. 11 – "Give us today our daily bread."

Asking God to give what we need is not selfish

- Matthew 7:11 & James 1:17
 "If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!"
 "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights"
- Giving to others what they need is like Him

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"Give us today our daily bread."

- Manna wasn't the only daily provision (Matthew 6:33-34)
 (Yesterday is over, & tomorrow isn't here yet)
- Heartbeat, Breath, Faith, Hope, Love, Grace, Mercy...
- We get **everything** from Him, (**I Cor. 4:7**)

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- "Give us today our daily bread."
 - Not only for ourselves (Acts 2:44-45 & Phil.
 2:4)
 - Yes, food & provision. (I Kings 17 & II Kings
 4)
 - Flour & Oil

More importantly – **The Bread of Life** - **John 6:23-69** (selected)

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Vs. 12 – "And forgive us our debts, as we also <u>have</u> forgiven our debtors."

- We ask **from You** what **we <u>gave</u> others** in Your name
 - Matthew 7:2 (You'll get what you give)
- We prayed "Our Father" with Jesus
- We cannot be **unlike** Him with Him

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Vs. 13 – "And lead us not into temptation,"

- In addition to what preceded, please always *lead us, Lord*
- "Lead us" contains the purpose of movement toward "set at one again"
- Move us toward oneness with You

"And lead us not into temptation"

- Away from, opposite to
- Temptation = Solicitation, Provocation (James 1:13)
- Jesus conquered temptation (by the devil, not God)...
- For us (Hebrews 2:18) God tested, Satan tempted

What temptation?

- Unforgiveness seems to be the Big one (Vs. 12, 14&15)

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"But deliver us from the evil one."

 As with birth – the mother **from** the trials of labor (Not the child from captivity)

What does he traffic in?

- **Unforgiveness**. He can't give forgiveness
- He hates forgiveness & wants to steal, kill & destroy it
- Especially among us. Why?
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Vs. 14-15... "IF"

Forgiveness is OF God ...

- It delivers people from sin, and...
- It empowers us to free others from sin

Unforgiveness excludes people from God

- It robs us of His freedom, and of offering His freedom
- It **robs God** of us, and Christ of **the reward** of His sacrifice

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Vs. 14 Is the reality that is "Us" including Jesus

- God's perfect cure for sin
- "When they sin against you"
- They will

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Vs. 15 Is us holding others captive in their sin

- God cannot be unjust
- He cannot allow **the sin of unforgiveness** in His kingdom

What is THE Big Thing Jesus does?

- He forgives sin at His own expense
- He makes it available ahead of time (Rom. 5:8)
