Vs. 1, "Finally" = It remains then...

.....

- First & Foremost "Rejoice in the Lord!"
- Everything we concern ourselves with starts there

Matt. 28:9, Christ's first post-resurrection Word: "Rejoice!"

- In the midst of their **earthly** suffering...
- He called them to **Eternal Joy!**
- **Always**, no matter what...

.....

Matthew 5:12, Acts 5:41 & 16:25 – Persecution

In public, in church, in jail

.....

Colossians 1:24 & **I Peter 4:13** – Sufferings & trials

Let **NOTHING** rob you of **rejoicing in Christ!**

Romans 8:18, "For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the alory that is to be revealed to us."

II Corinthians 4:7-10 & 16-18, "But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us. We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed. We always carry around in our body the death of

Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in our body."

"Therefore we do not give up. Even though our outer person is being destroyed, our inner person is being renewed day by day. For our momentary light affliction is producing for us an absolutely incomparable eternal weight of glory. So we do not focus on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal."

Vs. 2, "Beware of dogs" (evil workers & the mutilation)

He doesn't mean, "Man's best friend"

Apart from our trained pets, what do dogs do?

Dogs are **scavengers** who feed on discarded garbage

.....

- They scatter worthless remains (**gossip**)
- They **defecate** everywhere (my first house)
- Exposing what should be buried (I Peter 4:8)
- Unrestrained, they can become a pack of killers

Psalm 22:16, "For dogs have surrounded Me; a gang of evildoers has closed in on Me"

Psalm 59: (Selected)

Matthew 7:6, "Do not give what is holy to the dogs; nor cast your pearls before swine, lest they

trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you in pieces."	Paul didn't discard his former valuables to get rid of them
