Built On The Rock

Hebrews 12:26-29, His voice shook the earth at that time, but now He has promised, Yet once more I will shake not only the earth but also heaven. (Haggai 2:6) This expression, "Yet once more," indicates the removal of what can be shaken—that is, created things—so that what is not shaken might remain. Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us hold on to grace. By it, we may serve God acceptably, with reverence and awe, for our God is a consuming fire. (Deut. 4:24)

Matthew 7:24-25, "Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock: and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock."

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II Timothy 3:1-5, But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!

I Thessalonians 5:1-6, But concerning the times and the seasons, brothers and sisters, you have no need that I should write to you. For you yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night. For when they say, "Peace and safety!" then sudden destruction comes upon them, as labor pains upon a pregnant woman. And they shall not escape. But you, brothers and sisters, are not in darkness, so that this Day should overtake you as a thief. You are all children of light and children of the day. We are not of the night nor of darkness. Therefore let us not sleep, as others do, but let us watch and be self-controlled.

These are those times and seasons.

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One of my oldest & dearest friends is going through life threatening shaking.

 For the last two weeks his recovery has dominated my attention & concern

This week I said "Lord, I can't seem to disengage to prepare for Sunday."

He said, "I don't want you to."

Wednesday night as Revell & I were praying for several friends whose lives are being shaken severely...

- The Lord emphasized how essential we are to each other.

Romans 8:29, For those He foreknew He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, so that He would be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters.

How?	

In these times of **God's promised shaking**, as He separates temporal things from things of eternal value...

- His grace empowers us to be unshakeable for each other
- When our family & friend's lives are being shaken

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The first thing in the shaking is the removal of nonessential things

- Not necessarily bad, just not needed
- He may remove some things so we can need each other

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We are not made to be self-sufficient

- We need to need each other
- We need to be needed

Ecclesiastes 4:12, And if someone overpowers one person, two can resist him. A cord of three strands is not easily broken.

- Interdependent

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I Peter 2:4-5, Coming to Him as to a living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God and precious, you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

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The main difference between the rocks & stones are:

- The rocks are as they are found
- The stones are shaped

Ephesians 2:19-22. Now. therefore

Ephesians 2:19-22, Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone, in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, in whom you also are being
