# John 1:1-2, 14 & 18

"In the beginning was **the Word**, and the Word was with God, and **the Word was God**. He was in the beginning with God ... And **the Word became flesh** and dwelled among us... No one has ever seen God, but **the one and only Son, who is Himself God** and is in closest relationship with the Father, **has made him known**."

He has **revealed** God, He has **declared** Him, He **has put Him on display** among us **that we might** see Him and **know Him**.

Think of someone you've lived alongside... **someone** you love & know

- Do you know some of the colors they like?
- Can you say what some of the foods & music, books & movies they enjoy are?
- Have you shared some of those things with them?

Because you love and care about them

**How** do you know those things?

- Because you've spent time with them

- You're eager to be with them again

**That is why** God has gone to such great lengths to **make Himself known to us...**

That is why Jesus came, and it's what He did

### John 14:27, 16:33 & 20:19

.....

"Peace I leave with you, **My peace I give to you**; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid."

"These things I have spoken to you, that **in Me you may have peace**. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

"Then, the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in the midst, and said to them, 'Peace be with you.'"

What exactly is the One who **IS The Word**, offering us **in The Word**?

#### Psalm 19:7-11

"The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul"

**Law** is simply how things **really are** – like gravity

- God simply reveals how things really are
- Knowing and living accordingly in safe

**Soul** actually means **breathing** (being alive) – **Genesis 2:7** 

 Our aliveness needs conversion from fear to freedom by faith – believing God

"The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple"

**Testimony** is the same for us all...

- The verifiable evidence of how we've lived
- God's is sure certain and beyond question
- We don't even need to be that sharp just
  sharp enough to believe Him

"The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart"

**Statutes** are simply **written instructions** on how to **function** with what is

- They come with conviction (certainty) they not wrong – John 16:8
- He removes all guesswork
- And that makes us not only free, but happy

"The commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes"

**Commandments** are **requirements** only the author gets to make

- Have you ever tried to negotiate with computer software?
- How did that go?

Unlike human authors, God's are without corruption or error

 As light, they expose the error of anything that violates them

-	They enlighten us to see according to wha
	really is

"The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever"

This fear is not **fright** of being harmed

It is **Reverence – awe inspiring Reverence!** 

- It is the God given **knowledge** of His immeasurable **power**...
- Delivered in love, for **our benefit**...
- The very **object** and **purpose** of His creation...
- To freely share love with Him

Clean needs no explanation. Forever deserves
serious contemplation

"The judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether."

**Judgments** are the just **consequences** of chosen conduct

John 16:8 – He makes known the certain consequences of both good & evil

- And they are openly known to all who will believe
- None will ever accuse Him of injustice

"More to be desired are they than gold, Yes, than much fine gold;

Sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb."

"Moreover, by them Your servant is warned, And in keeping them there is great reward."

Are these **benefits of God's Word** desirable to you?

 Is there something else you would rather have at their expense?
