John 1:1-2, 14 & 18

"In the beginning was **the Word**, and the Word was with God, and **the Word was God**. He was in the beginning with God ... And **the Word became flesh** and **dwelled among us**..."

What does Jesus **occupy** on earth?

- His Word and His body

Ephesians 4:11-13 (*Vs.13)

"Until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ."

Is that what we're reaching for... our goal, our target?

- It's what **He lived & died for!**

(Beginning with the end in mind)

Romans 12:5

 "We, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another."

I Corinthians 12:12-27 (*Vs.27)

"Now **you are the body of Christ**, and individual members of it."

- How would you do without your pancreas?

- To what lengths do we go to preserve them when they're threatened?
