John 20:21, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you."

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What is our kingdom assignment?

John 13:34, "I give you a new command:
 Love one another. Just as I have loved you,
 you must also love one another."

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What did He say will happen if we do?

 John 13:35, "By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."
