What can we **confidently** ask God for that is **exactly like Jesus**?

- 1) A servant's heart, mind, identity, desires & opportunities
- 2) The growth of His fruit in our lives

John 15:16

"You did not choose Me, but I chose you. I appointed you that you should go out and **produce fruit** and that **your fruit** should remain, so that whatever you **ask** the Father **in My name**, He will give you."

- I Corinthians 12:31 says "desire", not ask

Galatians 5:22-23

"But the **fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith, gentleness, self-control. Against such things there is no law." That's **how we treat people**... not what we do for them.
