Beginning with **The End** in mind **Matthew 7:13-20**

"Enter" intending to go where it leads

Only one gate opens to eternal life ...

- And the way it leads to is **clearly defined**

Jesus IS that gate...

- And **He** defines the way

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John 10:1-15, "They did not understand the things which He spoke to them. Then Jesus said to them again, "Most assuredly, I say to you, I am the door"

John 14:6, "Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

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"Narrow is the gate and <u>difficult</u> is the way which leads to life"

- Difficult, hard, confined = "Clearly Defined"
- Like the marriage relationship...
 (Dating is not part of it)
- Like a "walled hallway", or clearly defined traffic lines & lanes...
 (Even turn lanes & lights)

OK... we're standing before the gate (Jesus).

- We believe Him and cross the threshold to enter eternal life with Him
- Does the gate hinge on **the right** or **the left**?
- Does it open to the left or to the right?
- Which way **will I be facing** when I enter?
- Do they **both** lead to **the same destination**?
- Do our social, political, economic or philosophical views **define the path**?
- For us, or anyone else?

This has always been a problem

- Matthew 7:1-5
- Romans 14:4-13
- James 3:2-18

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Jesus **IS** the gate, and **He** defines the path

- What is the path, and how did we get to this place on it?
- He's been defining it since **5:3**

How many people **name Jesus**, then define the path...

- **By their own** social, political, economic or philosophical **views**?
- And do so **without** a thought for **Matthew 5:3-10**

How has He **defined the path** so far?

- **5:3-12**, How we live in response to God & with other people
- 5:13-16, In our clearly revealed calling
- 5:17-20, By Christ's example, not religious standards
- 5:21-48, By relational applications of 5:5-9
- 6:1-18, For God's approval only
- 6:19-24, Living for eternal, not earthly values
- **6:25-34**, By entrusting our entire life to Him... **daily**
- 7:1-12, By asking & seeking for others, what we want from God (Like He did for us)

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Then He tells us, this is **not optional**, and...

- Be careful **who you follow**

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"Beware of false prophets... You will know them by their fruits."

- What they display & offer you
- They are inviting you to enter, and go another way
- Not only blatant sin, but often attractive self-indulgences...
- Living like Rock Stars, declaring **wealth** as God's reward
- I Timothy 6:3-9

Jesus invites us to join Him in the **life of eternal value** now...

He goes into great detail to define that life... - And warn of the pitfalls

He wants us to enjoy **the fullness** & **freedom of life**...

- And He doesn't leave us guessing what that is
