Our leadership wants to more clearly define and make known...

- Who we are supposed to be, and
- What we are here to do

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God's Word is clear

Ephesians 4:11-16 (Vs. 12-13)

"... equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying (Building up) of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity (**Oneness**) of the faith and of the knowledge (Understanding) of the Son of God, to a perfect man (Mature person), to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ"

- Biblical Unity is not agreement!
- It is **BEING** indivisibly **ONE** together...
- In identity, understanding, purpose & surrender
- "Nevertheless, not what I will, but what You will." (Mark 14:36)

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As His Body **we are supposed to be** (individually & together)

- Actively serving (In various expressions)
- To build up Christ's body (the church)
- In the complete Oneness of love together (John 13:34-35 & 17:20-23)
- Just as Christ Himself (Matt. 20:28, John. 20:21 & I John 4:17)

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Matthew 6:10, "Your kingdom come. *Your* will be done on earth as it is in heaven."

In our world that is dividing against itself as never before...

- Our challenge of **ONENESS** is to **not be** like the world

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Six ways **Christ's Body is not** like the world:

- 1) The world is about productivity, measured by output
- The Body of Christ is about relationship
- measured by love demonstrated
- 2) The world is about what we want, determined by our values
- The Body of Christ is about what God wants
- Determined by what He reveals in His Word
- 3) The world is conditional I'm in if I get what I want
- The Body of Christ is Sacrificial
- I'll pay, even suffer **to bring you what God wants** for you
- 4) The world operates by control Business, Military, etc.
- The Body of Christ operates by serving & submission
- Matthew 20:25-28
- *5)* The world *strategizes* to *achieve* its objectives

- The Body of Christ Follows God's leading to receive His
- John 5:19 & 20:21, and Acts 16:6-10
- 6) The world is open to separation & division (even causes it)
- The Body of Christ embraces total commitment
- "Peace" = absolute relational security
- Matthew 5:9, John 14:27 & 20:21
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Matthew 13 has six illustrations of what God's kingdom is like

Matthew 13:33 says, "The kingdom of heaven is like yeast that a woman took and mixed into 50 pounds of flour until it spread through all of it."

Would we – you, me & us – *aspire to be* mixed into (an ingredient of) the community we live in, *deliberately active* for the purpose of *demonstrating the love of Christ*?

- What's the big difference between us and yeast?
- We must choose to be present for the purpose of being influential
- If not, we become inert! (Matthew 5:13)
