I John 4:17-19, Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world. There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love. We love (Him) because He first loved us.

- Love loves first (**Matt.22:37-40**)

**10:12-13**, "And when you go into a household, greet it. If the household is worthy, let your peace come upon it. But if it is not worthy, let your peace return to you."

- Offer your genuine relationship. Be authentic.
- You're there in Christ's behalf
- Set the tone you hope to cultivate

"If the household is worthy, let your peace come upon it."

- If genuine relationship is offered in return
- Real relationship is reciprocal, **not required**

"Let your peace come upon it."

"Set at one again", Absolute relational safety & security

.....

The peace "Of" God, in Christ, with each other

(John 17:20-24)

#### That peace **is the testimony of the kingdom**

- Given freely by The King
- Offered freely in His behalf
- Matthew 5:9, "Peacemakers"

"But if it is **not worthy**, let your peace return to you."

......

- If not receptive & reciprocal, or contrary

"Let your peace return to you."

- Don't establish yourself in an inhospitable environment
- Don't start someplace vulnerable to contention (Psalm 1:1)
- Leave in good graces, with your peace unchallenged
- We are offering peace, not defending it

.....

**10:14**, "If anyone will not welcome you or listen to your words, **shake the dust off your feet when you leave** that house or town."

- Don't carry any un-peaceable contention with you
- Leave it behind

10:15, "Assuredly, I say to you, it will be more tolerable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment than for that city!"

- Sodom and Gomorrah did not have the light Christ's life
- These will have been offered & rejected His life and love

**John 1:4, 11** & **3:19**, In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.... He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. (**10:5-6**)

.....

And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

**10:16**, "Behold, **I send you** out as **sheep** in the midst of wolves. Therefore be wise as serpents and harmless as doves."

- Sheep, going where your Shepherd leads
- To occupy in His behalf, as with Him
- Examples of trusting faith (8:23-26)

.....

"As sheep in the midst of wolves.

- John 20:21 & Psalm 23:5
- Knowing the environment will be hostile
- Do not fear (**Psalm 23:4**)
- You have seen My power (Over the storm & the demoniac)

"Therefore be **wise as serpents** and harmless as doves."

- Cunning, vigilant & skilled at avoiding danger
- Snakes seem to know the world hates them
- I don't know if Paul understood this clearly

..... "Be wise as serpents and harmless as doves."

- Not as aggressively, to conquer
- No one feels threatened by a dove
- The very picture of the Spirit of God (Matt. 3:16)

**10:17**, But **beware of men**, for they will deliver you up to councils and scourge you in their synagogues.

- Adam's first offspring murdered his brother, who was obeying God
- Matthew 7:13-14, Most choose the wide gate & broad road
- Matthew 12:30, Not receiving Him is opposition to Him

.....

"They will deliver you up to councils and scourge you in their synagogues."

- Those who love darkness feel **exposed by** the light
- Like Cain, some want to extinguish it

10:18, "You will be brought before governors and kings for My sake, as a testimony to them and to the Gentiles."

- Government officials who believe they are the ultimate authority in life
- They do not submit to God's authority, or those who obey Him
- Hitler killed Bonhoeffer, and worked to coopt or silence the Church

.....

"Before governors and kings for My sake"

- Matt. 5:10-12, Be sure your stand is FOR Me!
- Not some civil, political, or private cause
- Don't do **in My name**, anything I would not
- Jesus is not a campaign endorsement

"As a testimony to them and to the Gentiles."

......

- As testimony to **who He is**, and **who we are** (Acts. 1:8)
- That God's family is not a racial identity (Matt. 12:49-50)

10:19-20, "But when they deliver you up, do not worry about how or what you should speak. For it will be given to you in that hour what you should speak; for it is not you who speak, but the Spirit of your Father who speaks in you."

- "When they deliver you up"... not if. So be prepared
- Philippians 4:6-7, Replace your anxiety with God's own peace
- Matthew 4:1-11, Jesus already set our example, "It is written"

.....

"For it is not you who speak, but the Spirit of your Father who speaks in you."

John 16:13-14, "However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will quide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you."

John 14:26, But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.

- So, give Him something to work with
- Spend time in God's Word
- Psalm 119:11 & Romans 12:2
- Fill the pantry of your heart & mind with His Word

What is the most important part of Christ's demonstration of power?

......

- The power of **what He does?**
- Or the power of **who He is?**

## He is turning a big corner, **handing His power to His disciples**

- There are three points to taking a race car through a corner
- 1) Entering the corner, 2) the apex of the corner 3) exiting the corner
- They, and we are the car. The Holy Spirit is the driver

He has taken them & us into the corner

- We're at the critical point of the apex
- Preparing to exit the corner on the straightaway
- He wants us to **come out strong!**

### On a racetrack, the **preparation of the car is** critical!

- Our driver, the Holy Spirit, knows what He's doing
- But a poorly prepared car can go in the ditch with the best driver
- Jesus is giving us **His own Power**

What will be the most important part of **our use of His power**?

- What we do, or who we are?
- Which will determine how we use what He has entrusted to us?
- Many are captivated by what we do, more than who we are
