Doing Good, Being Good & Kind

How are you? It's a very common greeting we're often asked

- It's not uncommon the reply "Good" with a smile
- We're often blessed that someone cared enough to ask.

Galatians 5:22-23, "The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith/fulness, gentleness, self-control.

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God's law is simply the way things really are

- And He is kind enough to tell us how it all works
- Even how fruit is grown and its purpose

God made everything that is

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 John 1:3, All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

The laws of physics are God's laws.

- That's how He made the things He created to work
- His moral laws are how He made people to work
- (Sin was not made, it was chosen by created beings)

Physics reveals that for every action there is an equal & opposite reaction

- God authored action is **for** something.
- Reaction is the reverse, or opposite action...
- In both God's physical & moral laws

For every loving virtue of God...

- The enemy has an opposite reaction against it
- Love/Hate, Joy/Sorrow, Faith/Fear,
 Kindness/Cruelty, Goodness/Evil
- Everything in opposition to God's moral ways is evil, and is sin

Evil has a target it wants to hinder or destroy!

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- God's goodness in our life; yours, mine & ours together...
- Loving relationship with God, each other & everyone else
- Matthew 22:37-40 & John 13:34

Remember – God doesn't play defense! (**Matt. 16:18**)

- Neither do we in His behalf!!

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- God's goodness is not passive
- We actively cultivate fruit to be offered to other people

If & when the enemy tries to hinder or oppose us...

- Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good. (Romans 12:21)
- "You are the light of the world." Light displaces darkness. ALWAYS!!!

Luke 10:19, "Behold, I give you the authority to
trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the
power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any
means hurt you."

How did Jesus use His authority to dispatch the enemy?

- Matthew 4:1-11 & Luke 4:1-13
- Luke was a Gentile. All who are Christ's have the same power available
- We don't go hunting the enemy Francis
 Schaeffer
- If he's in our God authored path, that's his problem.
- Our response is to do as Jesus did... or by simply ignoring him as irrelevant.

What is evil? What kept Israel from entering the promised land?

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Hebrews 3:12-13, Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God; but exhort one another daily, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

......**Unbelief is evil**, and sin against God

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- Unbelief believes God is **not good**

Genesis 3:1, Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made. And he said to the woman, "**Has God indeed said**, 'You shall not eat of every tree of the garden'?"

- He entices us to believe God is not for us
- He accuses God of withholding the truth & keeping us down
- He tempts us to believe that God is not good

Luke 4:1-13, Every temptation offered to Christ was a distortion of God's word

- Knowing & believing God's word is our authority over every unbelief
- Many churches have gone astray attempting to redefine God's word...
- The revealed goodness of who God is & who He is in us

Several of last week's scriptural examples of "kindness"

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- Used the same word also translated as "goodness"
- Some translations use the different of the two in the same verse

Romans 2:4, Or do you despise the riches of **His kindness/goodness**, restraint, and patience, not recognizing that **God's kindness/goodness** is intended to lead you to repentance?

 Is someone confused? No. They are both true without violating each other

They are two sides of the same coin, stamped with God's image

- Kindness is good, and Goodness is kind
- Neither translation is incorrect

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Other expressions of goodness are about "being
good" and "doing good"

Luke 6:35, "But love your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High. For He is kind/good to the unthankful and evil."

- "do good" is spot on, "doing good"
- "kind/good" is "Useful, excellent character... with gentleness"

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II Thessalonians 1:11, Therefore we also pray always for you that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfill all the good (to do good) pleasure of His goodness (to be good) and the work of faith with power

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I Peter 2:15, For this is the will of God, that by doing good you may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men

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I Peter 3:16-17, having a good (demonstrated) conscience, that when they defame you as evildoers, those who revile your good conduct in Christ may be ashamed. For it is better, if it is the will of God, to suffer for doing good (being seen doing good) than for doing evil.

(Holman) However, do this with gentleness and respect, keeping your conscience clear, so that when you are accused, those who denounce your Christian life (good conduct) will be put to

shame. For it is better to suffer for doing good , if that should be God's will, than for doing evil.
Galatians 5:22-23, "The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith/fulness, gentleness, self-control.
In Matthew 19 Jesus was asked, "What good must I do to have eternal life?" - Jesus answered, "There is only One who is

good."

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How are you?

- Let's answer "good" with confidence
- Having a "Useful, excellent character... with gentleness"
- Handling people with care, good will & understanding
- Being good & kind to everyone, even the unthankful & evil
- Overcoming evil with the goodness of God in us, whether received or not
