Galatians 5:22-23, The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith/fulness, gentleness, self-control. What comes to mind when you think of gentleness?	Just as Kindness & Goodness are translated from the same word - Gentleness & Meekness both come from the same word - Gentleness is meek, & meekness is gentle
Can gentleness make you vulnerable in this hostile world? - Yes, maybe. But gentleness is a fruit of love (I Cor. 13:4-8) - And real love remains uncorrupted by adversity - There is nothing more vulnerable than love - Love does not need to protect or defend itself	Colossians 1:15-17, He is the image of the invisible God For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth All things were created through Him and for Him and in Him all things consist. (John 1:3) Colossians 2:9-10, For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily; and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.
 Who comes to mind when you think of gentleness? Someone you are, or have been safe with Someone you are willingly vulnerable to But not at risk with Do you think of them as strong? 	The gentle & meek Jesus created & maintains the entire Universe! The same <u>Source</u> of gentleness & power found in the fruit of the Spirit
Matthew 11:29, "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." - A promise from Jesus - Do we want to be like Him?	John 16:13-14, "However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you."
 His rest subdues what our rest cannot (Heb.3:7-4:16) 	- Declare = Rehearse (John 1:18)

Everything the Holy Spirit offers & demonstrates for us...

- He obtains from the powerful gentleness of who Jesus is
- Remember, none of these fruit are separate or individual
- They are collaborative & interdependent

We need to discard our earthly sense of power & influence

- God does not use it to establish & rule His kingdom!
- Earthly power & conquest is a violation of Christ's demonstrated power
