## The Heart, Hands & Feet of Faith

(Foundations of Faith, pt.4)

James 1:2-4, My brethren (family of the original
womb), count it all joy when you fall into various
trials, knowing that the testing of your faith
produces perseverance. But let perseverance
have its perfect work, that you may be mature and
complete, lacking nothing.

Jame's first reference to faith is not about miraculous outcomes

- Trials that test our faith = "Proving through adversity"
- Perseverance/endurance indicates over time
- Great faith is **faith enough to wait**
- Weak faith demands an answer right now

As we saw in "First Faith" in Luke 17:5-10...

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- Growing faith occurs as we persist in our work of service
- As with all seed growth (**Matthew 13:3-9** & **16-23**)...
- It has to do with the soil of our lives that nurtures it

1:5-6, If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. But let him ask in faith, with no doubting

- Wisdom originates & resides IN God...
- It is obtained from Him by faith (Ephesians 2:8)
- Faith asks God for His promises (not our wishes) in confidence

**1:6-8**, for he who **doubts** (God will give what He promised) is a double-minded man, **unstable in all his ways**.

- Wanting from God without faith is instability and unwise...
- "In all his ways" across the spectrum of life
- Knowledge knows what's going on in life
- The wisdom of faith knows how to live confidently

How might Jesus respond to any situation in faith...

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- And how should I/we? (John 5:19 & 20:21)
- Faith reveals the way; step by step & day by day
- If we're not actively relying on God Why not?

**1:12**, A man who **endures** trials is blessed, because **when he passes the test** he will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love Him.

- It appears to be **a lifelong process** 

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**1:22**, But be **doers** of the word, and **not** hearers only, **deceiving yourselves**. (Luke 6:46)

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2:14-17, What does it profit, my brethren, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can faith save him? If a brother or sister is naked and destitute of daily food, and one of you says to them, "Depart in peace, be warmed and

filled," but you **do not give them the things which are needed** for the body, what does it profit? Thus also faith by itself, **if it does not have works**, is dead (lifeless).

- Matthew 7:26-27

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**2:18**, But someone will say, "You have faith, and I have works." Show me your faith **without** your works, and I will **show** you **my faith by my works**.

- Daily **seed faith grows** & produces evidence
- Matthew 13:23, In the good soil of our hearts
- Luke 13:18-19 & 17:5-10 (Mustard seed)

Linear results with bounts full of some results

I know people with hearts **full of compassion** who long for **miracles of faith**:

- Healing, recovery, rescue, provision & more
- Are they continuing in first faith with food, clothing & assistance when it is needed?
- Matthew 25:44-45

**2:1-4**, My brethren, **do not hold the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ**, the Lord of glory,

with partiality. For if there should come into your assembly a man with gold rings, in fine apparel, and there should also come in a poor man in filthy clothes, and you pay attention to the one wearing the fine clothes and say to him, "You sit here in a good place," and say to the poor man, "You stand there," or, "Sit here at my footstool," have you not shown partiality among yourselves, and become judges with evil thoughts?

- Faith knows **no favoritism** 

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My uncle Art... my Aunt's checkbook

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- Hugely successful in business, a giant oak tree
- He knew he was still a seed, not yet a tree in the church

**2:21-22**, Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he **offered** Isaac his son on the altar? Do you see that faith was working together with his works, and **by works faith was made complete**?

- More than **40 years after he received the** seed of faith in his heart...
- **It grew into the completeness** of offering the most valuable thing in his life
- The God given foundation of God's promise to him

First – Do we believe God with our life?

- Not only with our mind
- Living to serve Him

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**Next** – Are we actively **looking** & **listening** in faith for His further direction?

- Committed to obeying Him, before He reveals anything else
- Living to hear Him say, "Well done, good & faithful servant"

**Lastly** – Serving all people equally, **without favoritism** 

- In a world of judgement & condemnation
- Being the offer of His Peace in faith, to everyone we encounter
- John 14:27 & 20:21

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
