Matt 5:6

- *What is Righteousness? -Doing what is right *How do you determine what is right? -The highest good (several philosophical theories of what the highest good is). Perfection, enduring, enjoying *God personifies what is good. -He is perfect in that He needs nothing (Acts 17:24-25) -He endures in that He is immortal (I Tim 1:17) -He enjoys (Luke 12:22-34) *Correction: He doesn't align with what is good. He defines what is good and has a purpose for us to share in His Righteousness. *Seek it first Matt 6:33 (parallel passage to Luke 12) *You will receive the tools to be righteous if you are hungry for it (Matt 5:6) *It's needed for kingdom entry. What God has said is not to be swept away but fulfilled (Matt 5:17-20) *John came in righteousness (Matt 21:32) -Repent, do good, point to Jesus (Luke 3:7-20) *Do good to others (Matt 25:37-40) *The righteous have a true sense of sin (Luke 18:9-14) *Some may appear righteous, but only outwardly, be wary (Matt 23:27-28) -Spies pretended to be righteous (Luke 20:20) *Persecution can come from being righteous (Matt 5:10) -Abel was righteous (Matt 23:35) He gave worship to God through his work (Gen 4:4) -and was killed for it (Gen 4:8)
- *In the end we will shine as the sun. Molten refined gold? (Matt 13:37-43)
