The Gift of Christ!

Galatians 4:4-5, "But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons."

How was He sent?

Luke 2:19, 26-27 "I am Gabriel, who stands in the presence of God, and was **sent to speak to you** and bring you these glad tidings."

"In the sixth month, **the angel Gabriel was sent by God** to a town in Galilee called Nazareth, **to a virgin**engaged to a man named Joseph, of the house of
David. The virgin's name was Mary."

Jesus was not sent like that

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Gabriel is **a created being** – not created in the image and likeness of God

Jesus IS the uncreated Creator!

John 1:1-3, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made."

Jesus IS God... Who sent Gabriel to announce **Himself**

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Philippians 2:5-7, "Let this mind be in you **which** was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of

God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, but **made Himself of no reputation**, taking the form of a bondservant, and **coming in the likeness of men**."

Jesus chose to come... He sent Himself

Vs. 8, "And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross."

Though God Himself, as a man...

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- He chose to "become" obedient, even "to the point of death."
- (Daniel 3:16-18)
