My soul magnifies the Lord! "He who is mighty has done great things for me"

Luke 1:38-56

.....

Vs. 38, After the angel Gabriel announces God's calling on her life (*Vs. 26-37*)

- Mary declares her relationship with God
- "**Behold**" = Be certain as you see me. This is who I am.
- "The **maidservant** of **the Lord!**" = Voluntary slave, subserviency & subjection
- "Let it be to me according to your word" Surrender, Submission & Subjection

This is the foundation of **who she was already**...

.....

.....

That is our calling, too...

- To bring forth the life of God's Son through us, without reservation
- Acts 1:8, "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be My witnesses..." = Martyr (Acts 22:20, Stephen)

So... are we?

- Voluntary slaves, subservient in subjection to God?
- Romans 1:1, Paul uses the same word, "Bondservant"
- **A ready sacrifice** like Mary, Stephen, Shadrach, Meshach & Abed-nego
- **None of them knew** if it would be required of them
- But because it was who they made themselves to be...

 In response to who God is... they didn't hesitate

.....

Vs. 39-40, "Mary arose and went with haste…, to the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth."

- Word of Elizabeth's miraculous pregnancy had spread
- But, **no one else knew of Mary's** even more miraculous conception...
- Much less WHO her baby was
- Does she go hoping for someone who will understand?
- Elizabeth's pregnancy brough great joy!
- What sort of reception might Mary anticipate?

.....

Vs. 41-42, "When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the baby leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit."

"Then she exclaimed, "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb!"

- Mary knows no one else knows. It's too early to be showing
- Only God could reveal this
- She doesn't need to worry about breaking this news

Vs. 43-45, "But why am I so favored, that **the mother of my Lord** should come to me? As soon as the sound of your greeting reached my ears, the baby in my womb leaped for joy. **Blessed is she** **who has believed** that the Lord would fulfill His promises to her!"

- **Double Shock!!** She not only knows she's pregnant...
- She knows who she's pregnant with!
- This is the gift of **Word of Knowledge** (I Cor. 12:8)
- Who's ministry is it anyway, Mary, Liz & us? (Acts 1:8)
- The Holy Spirit

"Blessed is she who has believed... that the Lord would fulfill His promises to her!"

- Liz also knows God has made promises to her
- You could think Mary might be speechless...
 She wasn't

.....

Vs. 46-49, And Mary said:

"My soul magnifies the Lord,

And **my spirit rejoices in God my Savior**.

For He has regarded the lowly state of His maidservant;

For behold, henceforth all generations will call me blessed.

For He who is mighty **has done great things for me**, And holy is His name."

"My soul magnifies the Lord"

In the inexplicable reality of what God has called me to...

- I expand beyond my own comprehension my belief in who He Is!
- He has so amazed me that I cannot define **my sense of His Greatness!!**
- I am overwhelmed with joy because of His involvement in my life

"For He who is mighty **has done great things for me**"

- I count them as done already

.....

Having **identified herself as God's slave** to Gabriel...

- She declares He has redefined her further

Vs. 51-53, She goes on to say...

"He has scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts. (Babel)

He has put down the mighty from their thrones, And exalted the lowly.

He has filled the hungry with good things, (Matt. 5:6)

And the rich He has sent away empty."

.....

How highly exalted to be **called to bring Christ** to the world!

- How unlike the values of the world He is
- And calls us to join Him in it
- Philippians 2:5-8, "Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, who, being in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death"

.....

Has God made promises to you, personally?

- There are promises He's made to us all plural
- Romans 8:29, "For those He foreknew He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son"

.....

As humans, there's the risk of thinking **our desires** are God's promises

- How easily Eve transposed God's words, before she sinned

Be certain, that what He actually promised, **He WILL fulfill**

- Even those in Hebrews 11:13 & 36-39
- "These all died in faith without having received the promises, but they saw them from a distance, welcomed them, and confessed that they were foreigners and temporary residents on the earth."

- When, where & how He fulfills them is in His perfect will

.....

Our hindsight lets us eagerly identify with her

- And well we should

But it was **her identity** & **foresight** that compelled her to agree

- That is where we need to join her
- Knowing **we are highly favored** to called by Him
- And *rejoicing* in what He has promised...
- Even before He accomplishes it
