Matthew 13:33.

He told them another parable. "The kingdom of heaven is like **leaven** that a woman took and **hid** in three measures of flour, till it was all leavened."

Leaven brings subtle, inconspicuous, fervent influence

Leaven =

- Mitigation of solace
- Makes a general **change in the mass**
- Alters the quality of something
- Causes a gradual change

Matthew 13:3 is the ONLY positive reference, O.T. & N.T.

Good & bad both equal influence

"Hid" = to conceal & incorporate

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Will we deliberately determine to inconspicuously incorporate ourselves in the world we live in; being...

- In it, but not of it
- For the purpose of **being influential**
- Living to make a difference by Being different?

When you go to work each day... do you **mentally purpose** to **DO** what your job description identifies as your assignment?

If not, you may not have your job for long

A young man told me he was fired for preaching the gospel.

- I told him he was fired for stealing from his employer
- Sadly, he did it in Jesus' name

When we're "hidden" in the world around us, the question is...

- Will we be **influential**... Or **influenced**?

We're supposed to know that we happen to it

Romans 12:2, "Do not be conformed to this age, but be transformed by **the renewing of your mind**, so that you may discern what is the good, pleasing, and perfect will of God." Transformed by the convictions of God's Word & Will The whole transaction reminds me of Matthew 5:13, "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men." "looses its flavor" is from a single, compound Greek word that means: To **become** stupid Stupid is voluntary – an unwillingness to learn So, will we... live to be **the influence of Christ**? To not, is to consign the influence to the world! Matthew 12:30 – there is NO middle ground "Anyone who is not with Me is against Me, and anyone who does not gather with Me scatters." Faith in Christ is **not** passive So, our next question is... "How Will We Love Them Now?" To make a difference In the world...

It doesn't happen to us
